16	(3) The amount of the renewal fee.
17 18	(c) Each licensee or certificate holder shall notify the Board of any change in the address of the licensee or certificate holder.
19 20 21	(d) Before the license or certificate expires, the licensee or certificate holder periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee or certificate holder:
22	(1) Otherwise is entitled to be licensed or certified;
23	(2) Pays to the Board the renewal fee set by the Board;
