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- 2 (F) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "TOTAL DIRECT EDUCATION AID"
 3 MEANS THE TOTAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE STATE TO A
 4 COUNTY BOARD UNDER THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:
- 5 (I) FUNDING FOR THE FOUNDATION PROGRAM INCLUDING 6 FUNDS FOR THE GEOGRAPHIC COST OF EDUCATION UNDER THIS SECTION;
- 7 (II) Transportation aid under § 5-205 of this 8 subtitle;
- 9 (III) FUNDING FOR COMPENSATORY EDUCATION UNDER § 10 5–207 OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- 11 (IV) FUNDING FOR STUDENTS WITH LIMITED ENGLISH 12 PROFICIENCY UNDER § 5–208 OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- 13 (V) Funding for special education students under § 14 5–209 of this subtitle;

- 19 (2) If A COUNTY BOARD'S TOTAL DIRECT EDUCATION AID IN THE 20 CURRENT FISCAL YEAR IS LESS THAN THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR BY MORE THAN 7%, THEN THE STATE SHALL PROVIDE A GRANT TO THE COUNTY BOARD IN AN 22 AMOUNT NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT A DECREASE IN TOTAL DIRECT 23 EDUCATION AID IS NOT MORE THAN 7%.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, when the Maryland State Department of Education issues a contract to conduct a study of the adequacy of education funding in the State as required by Chapter 288 of 2002, the study shall include the impact on State funding of declining enrollments in local school systems with small enrollments.
- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2011. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June 30, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
