A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health – Medical Procedures – Ultrasound Options**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain physicians, under certain circumstances, to
4 provide a certain pregnant woman the opportunity to view a certain ultrasound
5 image and offer to provide the woman with a certain picture before the
6 performance or inducement of a certain medical procedure; requiring a
7 physician to allow a certain pregnant woman to view a certain ultrasound image
8 at no additional charge; and generally relating to ultrasound options for medical
9 procedures.

10 BY adding to

11 Article – Health – General
12 Section 20–210
13 Annotated Code of Maryland

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Health – General**

18 **20–210.**

19 **(A) IF AN OBSTETRIC ULTRASOUND EXAMINATION IS PERFORMED AT**
20 **ANY TIME BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE OR INDUCEMENT OF AN ABORTION OR**
21 **THE PHYSICIAN PERFORMING OR INDUCING THE ABORTION DETERMINES THAT**
22 **AN ULTRASOUND EXAMINATION WILL BE PERFORMED AS PART OF THE**
23 **ABORTION PROCEDURE, BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE OR INDUCEMENT OF THE**
24 **ABORTION, THE PHYSICIAN SHALL:**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(1) PROVIDE THE PREGNANT WOMAN RECEIVING THE ABORTION**
2 **THE OPPORTUNITY TO VIEW THE ACTIVE ULTRASOUND IMAGE OF THE EMBRYO**
3 **OR FETUS; AND**

4 **(2) OFFER TO PROVIDE THE PREGNANT WOMAN WITH A PHYSICAL**
5 **PICTURE OF THE ULTRASOUND IMAGE OF THE EMBRYO OR FETUS.**

6 **(B) THE PHYSICIAN SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF**
7 **SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION AT NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE TO THE**
8 **PREGNANT WOMAN.**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2011.
