Division of Correction and Division of Parole and Probation – Reports and Records – Inmate's Place of Birth

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain case record that is assembled by the Division of $\mathbf{5}$ Correction for an inmate to include certain information on the place of birth of 6 the inmate under certain circumstances; requiring the Division of Correction to 7forward certain information from a case record to the United States 8 Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency if the case record indicates that 9 the individual is foreign born; requiring the Division of Parole and Probation to 10 forward certain information from a certain presentence investigation report to 11 the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency if the 12presentence investigation report indicates that the individual who is the subject 13of the report is foreign born; and generally relating to reports and records of the
