3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- 4 (1) the terms of the two new members of the State Board for 5 Professional Engineers established by this Act shall expire 5 years after they are 6 appointed; and
- 7 (2) the terms of the other members of the State Board for Professional 8 Engineers on October 1, 2011, shall expire in accordance with the staggering of terms 9 in effect on October 1, 2011.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
