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Property Tax Assessments - Physical Inspection of Property

- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that the State Department of 4 Assessments and Taxation or the supervisor of assessments for a county value 5 all real property once in every 3-year cycle based on an exterior physical 6 inspection of the real property; requiring the Department's review of each real 7 property assessment during a 3-year cycle to include a physical inspection 8 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to a requirement that the 9 State Department of Assessments and Taxation or the supervisor of 10 assessments value property based on an exterior physical inspection.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
