transportation priorities of local jurisdictions, and to compare and evaluate
certain transportation priorities of local jurisdictions; and generally relating to
the Blue Ribbon Commission on Maryland Transportation Funding.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 (i) On or before November 1, 2011, the Commission shall submit a final 7 report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, subject to § 2–1246 of 8 the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 June 1, 2011.
