# **SENATE BILL 844**

## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 State Retirement and Pension System – Transfer of Service Credit

3 FOR the purpose of providing that certain members of the Employees' Pension System may transfer certain service credit from the State Contributory Law 4  $\mathbf{5}$ Enforcement Officers' Pension System in a certain manner; requiring that 6 certain members of the Employees' Pension System who transfer certain service 7credit from the State Contributory Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System 8 complete and file certain forms with the Board of Trustees of the State 9 Retirement and Pension System by a certain date; defining a certain term; 10 providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to the transfer of service credit for members of the Employees' Pension 11 12System.

#### 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:

(a) In this section, "State Contributory Law Enforcement Officers' Pension
System" means the part of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System of the State
of Maryland that provides a contributory pension benefit under Title 26, Subtitle 2,
Part II of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

(b) This section applies to an individual who:

(1) on or after July 1, 1983, was employed in a law enforcement
position by the Maryland Transportation Authority and was a member of the State
Contributory Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System;

(2) on or after September 1999, ceased employment in a law
enforcement position with the Maryland Transportation Authority with more than 16
years of service credit in the State Contributory Law Enforcement Officers' Pension
System; and

1 (3) beginning on or after December 1, 1999, was employed in a nonlaw 2 enforcement position by the Maryland Transportation Authority and was a member of 3 the Employees' Pension System under Title 23 of the State Personnel and Pensions 4 Article;

5 (4) at the time the individual began employment in a nonlaw 6 enforcement position with the Maryland Transportation Authority and became a 7 member of the Employees' Pension System, was ineligible to transfer the years of 8 service credit in the State Contributory Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System to 9 the Employees' Pension System according to the provisions of Title 37 of the State 10 Personnel and Pensions Article.

11 (c) (1) An individual described in subsection (b) of this section may elect 12 to transfer to the Employees' Pension System the years of service credit the individual 13 accrued in the State Contributory Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System prior to 14 joining the Employees' Pension System.

15 (2) An individual who elects to transfer service credit under paragraph 16 (1) of this subsection shall be permitted to transfer the service credit in accordance 17 with Title 37 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

18 (d) To transfer service credit under subsection (c) of this section, an 19 individual shall complete a claim to transfer the service credit on a form provided by 20 the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System and file it with the 21 Board of Trustees on or before December 31, 2011.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2011. It shall remain effective for a period of 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
