State Board of Dental Examiners – Dentists – Informed Consent – Removal of Materials Containing Mercury

4 FOR the purpose of requiring dentists to obtain written informed consent from 5 patients prior to performing any dental procedures or treatments that include 6 the removal of dental materials containing mercury; specifying the content of 7 certain informed consent; requiring dentists to keep the original informed 8 consent in a certain chart; requiring the State Board of Dental Examiners to 9 adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to obtaining informed consent prior to performing any dental procedures or treatments that include the 10 removal of dental materials containing mercury. 11

- 21 (A) A DENTIST SHALL OBTAIN WRITTEN INFORMED CONSENT FROM A
 22 PATIENT PRIOR TO PERFORMING ANY DENTAL PROCEDURE OR TREATMENT
 23 THAT INCLUDES THE REMOVAL OF DENTAL MATERIALS CONTAINING MERCURY.

1	(B)	\mathbf{THE}	INFORMED	CONSENT	SHALL	CONTAIN	INFORMATION
2	REGARDING:						

- 3 (1) MERCURY VAPOR; AND
- 4 (2) THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF MERCURY EXPOSURE.
- 5 (C) THE DENTIST SHALL KEEP THE ORIGINAL WRITTEN INFORMED 6 CONSENT SIGNED BY A PATIENT IN THE DENTAL CHART OF THE PATIENT.
- 7 (D) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 8 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING THE CONTENT OF THE WRITTEN 9 INFORMED CONSENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
