A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Prior Authorizations of State Debt to Fund Capital Projects – Alterations

3 FOR the purpose of amending certain prior Acts of the General Assembly that 4 authorized the creation of State Debt through the issuance, sale, and delivery of $\mathbf{5}$ general obligation bonds, the proceeds of which were designated for funding 6 certain capital projects; extending the deadline by which certain loan proceeds 7 must be expended or encumbered by the Board of Public Works; extending the 8 deadline by which certain grantees must present evidence to the Board of Public 9 Works that certain matching funds will be provided; altering and expanding the 10 authorized uses of certain grants; altering the purpose of certain grants; 11 altering the grantees under certain projects; altering the location of certain 12facilities for which grants are to be received; altering the requirement that 13certain grantees provide a certain matching fund; altering the matching fund 14 requirements of certain grants; and generally relating to amending prior 15authorizations of State Debt by the General Assembly to fund certain capital 16 projects.

6 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on 7 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince 8 George's County – Palmer Park Boys and Girls Club Loan of 2001 in the total 9 principal amount of \$200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and 10 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of 11 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8–117 through 12 8–124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

13 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold 14 as a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds 15 under § 8–122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

16The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer (3)17and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and 18 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then 19shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the 20Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Palmer Park 2122Boys and Girls Club, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the 23planning, design, repair, renovation, and capital equipping of a facility at Barlowe Road in Palmer Park to house the Palmer Park Boys and Girls Club. 24

(4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
after the date of issuance of the bonds.

(5) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, [2011] **2013**. If any funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1, [2011] **2013**, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as provided in § 8–129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

32Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the (5)33 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either 3435 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of in kind contributions or funds 36 37 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of real property. 38 In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets 39 may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
