- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (a) IN THIS SECTION, "VENDING MACHINE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES"
 19 INCLUDES:
- 20(1) THE OPERATIONANDMAINTENANCEOF21CURRENCY-OPERATED VENDING MACHINES THAT DISPENSE PRODUCTS; AND

4 **(B)** The State or a State aided or controlled entity shall buy supplies and 5 services from:

6 (1) Maryland Correctional Enterprises, as provided in Title 3, Subtitle 7 5 of the Correctional Services Article, if State Use Industries provides the supplies or 8 services;

(2) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland, if:

10 (i) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland provides the 11 supplies or services OR, IN THE CASE OF VENDING MACHINE SUPPLIES AND 12 SERVICES, BLIND INDUSTRIES AND SERVICES OF MARYLAND EITHER PROVIDES 13 THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES OR SUBCONTRACTS FOR THE SUPPLIES OR 14 SERVICES; and

- 15 (ii) Maryland Correctional Enterprises does not provide the 16 supplies or services;
- 17 (3) the Employment Works Program established under § 14–108 of 18 this subtitle, if:
- 19 (i) a community service provider provides the supplies or 20 services;
- (ii) [neither] Maryland Correctional Enterprises [nor] DOES
 NOT PROVIDE THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES;

(III) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland [provides] DOES
 NOT PROVIDE the supplies or services OR, IN THE CASE OF VENDING MACHINE
 SUPPLIES AND SERVICES, BLIND INDUSTRIES AND SERVICES OF MARYLAND
 DOES NOT PROVIDE THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES OR SUBCONTRACT FOR THE
 SUPPLIES OR SERVICES; and

3 (III) Blind Industries and Services of [Maryland, nor] 4 MARYLAND DOES NOT PROVIDE THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES OR, IN THE CASE 5 OF VENDING MACHINE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES, BLIND INDUSTRIES AND 6 SERVICES OF MARYLAND DOES NOT PROVIDE THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES OR 7 SUBCONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES;

- 16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect17 October 1, 2011.
