A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

$\mathbf{2}$ State Vehicle Fleet – Use of Biofuels 3 FOR the purpose of altering the requirement that the State ensure that at least a 4 certain percentage of vehicles using diesel fuel in the State vehicle fleet use a $\mathbf{5}$ blend of fuel containing at least a certain percentage of biodiesel fuel to include 6 the use of certain biofuels; providing that a certain provision does not apply to a 7State vehicle, piece of heavy equipment, or heating equipment under certain 8 circumstances; and generally relating to the use of biofuels for the State vehicle 9 fleet 10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Finance and Procurement 11 12Section 14–408 13 Annotated Code of Maryland (2009 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement) 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17**Article – State Finance and Procurement** 14 - 408.18 19In this section, "biodiesel fuel" means: (a) 20a fuel, comprised of mono-alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids (1)21derived from vegetable oils or animal fats, that is designated B100 and meets the 22requirements of ASTM D 6751 and its successors; or

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1 (2) a blend of biodiesel fuel meeting ASTM D 6751 with 2 petroleum-based diesel fuel, designated as BXX, where XX represents the volume 3 percentage of biodiesel fuel in the blend.

4 (b) In fiscal year 2008 and in each subsequent fiscal year, the State shall 5 ensure that at least 50% of the vehicles using diesel fuel in the State vehicle fleet use a 6 blend of fuel that is at least 5% biodiesel fuel OR OTHER BIOFUEL APPROVED BY 7 THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AS A FUEL OR FUEL 8 ADDITIVE OR APPROVED UNDER THE EPA RENEWABLE FUELS STANDARD 2 9 PROGRAM.

10 (c) In fiscal year 2009 and in each subsequent fiscal year, the State shall 11 ensure that at least 50% of the heavy equipment owned by the State using diesel fuel 12 and at least 50% of the heating equipment in State buildings that uses normal or #2 13 heating oil use, subject to availability, a blend of fuel that is at least 5% biodiesel fuel 14 OR OTHER BIOFUEL APPROVED BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION 15 AGENCY AS A FUEL OR FUEL ADDITIVE OR APPROVED UNDER THE EPA 16 RENEWABLE FUELS STANDARD 2 PROGRAM.

17 (d) This section does not apply to any State vehicle, piece of heavy 18 equipment, or heating equipment for which mechanical failure due to use of biodiesel 19 fuel **OR OTHER BIOFUEL** will void the manufacturer's warranty for that vehicle, piece 20 of heavy equipment, or heating equipment.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2011.
