The Grantee is a municipal government and is responsible for public safety and police functions within the City of Laurel. Grantee is also responsible for management and administration of all city functions including the operation and management of the public works functions. The Barkman Kaiser Public Safety complex in addition to providing a state of the art police facility, will when phase two is completed provide an efficient and environmentally friendly facility for community public hearing and training and enable the City to more effectively communicate with residents and hold public forum meetings. The addition of a sally port at the rear of the facility will enable the City to more effectively meet safety and security requirements in the transport of prisoners to and from the police facility. Repairing the original parking lot with deep patching, milling and overlay will enable the City to extend the life of the parking facility as part of good management procedures. The addition of a paging system will improve internal communication.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The first phase of this project renovated the perimeter of the entire building and completed renovation of 30,000 square feet of the building for the Laurel Police Department. All of the existing bathrooms and support equipment in the building were located in the space for the Police Department and for security reasons are not accessible to the space designated for the Community Meeting Facility that is located on the 2nd floor of the building. Therefore Phase 2 of this project includes construction of new bathrooms, a commercial kitchen, new HVAC, a lift in the lobby to make the space ADA accessible, new lights (replaces the old church lights), modification of the stage area, removal of the old church baptistry, new flooring, and new paint. Window replacements were included in Phase I of this building renovation, however, use of this Community Meeting Facility will not be possible until completion of this project. There are a few police facility requirements that were deferred to Phase 3 due to funding constraints such as an audio/paging system, a secure ingress/egress entry system sally port for prisoners and parking lot repairs.
