Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2009 - Prince George's County -  
South Bowie Boys and Girls Club

---

This bill changes the name of the grantee for the South Bowie Boys and Girls Club project, as specified by the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2009. The current grantee is the Board of Directors of the South Bowie Boys and Girls Club, Inc.; the bill specifies that the project's grantee is the Mayor and City Council of the City of Bowie.

The bill extends a deadline for the grantee to present evidence of a matching fund to June 1, 2013. The proceeds of this loan must be encumbered by the Board of Public Works or expended by June 1, 2013.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2011.

Fiscal Summary

**State Effect:** The bill does not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

**Local Effect:** Absent the bill, the City of Bowie loses access to the \$50,000 in matching funds authorized for this project.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

Analysis

**Current Law:** Chapter 485 of 2009 authorized a grant of \$50,000 to the Board of Directors of the South Bowie Boys and Girls Club, Inc. for the construction of a

concession stand to be operated by the South Bowie Boys and Girls Club. Chapter 485 requires the grantee to expend a matching fund of \$25,000. The matching fund may not consist of real property, in-kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the June 1, 2009 effective date of Chapter 485.

**Background:** The South Bowie Boys and Girls Club advises that the proposed grantee change was requested because the organization prefers allowing the City of Bowie to manage the project. The South Bowie Boys and Girls Club further advises that matching funds have been raised for the project and the project should be finished by the fall of 2011.

The project involves the construction of a permanent facility at Church Road Field in Bowie to be used as a concession stand. The proposed 1,000 square-foot facility will be equipped with running water, restrooms, and sewer facilities.
