10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Tri-County Council for the Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland was formed by an Act of the Maryland General Assembly in 2001. The purpose of the Council is to facilitate regional planning and economic development in Somerset, Wicomico and Worcester counties. The voting members of the Council are the five Somerset County Commissioners, four of the seven Wicomico County Council members, the Wicomico County Executive, five of the seven Worcester County Commissioners, one municipal representative from each of the three Counties, and the members of the General Assembly who have a majority of their district within the three counties. The Council meets quarterly. The Council has five committees: Water & Sewer, Geographic Information Systems (GIS), Telecommunications, Regional Health Care, Infrastructure and CEDS. These committees meet on a routine basis as needed. In order to increase coordination and share resources, Shore Transit, the Lower Shore's public transportation provider, and the Lower Shore Workforce Alliance (LSWA) became divisions of the Tri-County Council in July 2004.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The purpose of this project is to consolidate Workforce Development, Economic Development and Public Transportation in the Tri-County region of Somerset, Wicomico and Worcester counties on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. This consolidation of services into one campus is the most effective means of delivering these services to the public. The project will include the renovation of an existing manufacturing facility into professional office space and the addition of approximately 260 parking spaces. The following offices/agencies will be housed in the building: Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development; Job Corps; Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation; Lower Shore Workforce Alliance; Rehabilitation Services; Telamon; MAC, Inc.; Wicomico County Department of Social Services; MD Department of Human Resources - Child Support Enforcement Administration; Tri-County Workforce Initiative; Shore Transit; One-Stop Job Market and the Tri-County Council for the Lower Eastern Shore of Maryland.
