AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 150, AS AMENDED  
(Third Reading File Bill – Committee Reprint)

On page 223, after line 39, insert:

“SECTION 46. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That appropriations contained in Section 1 of this Act are reduced by \$314,160,000 in General Funds and \$14,000,000 in federal funds as follows:
