AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 643  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Abandoned” and substitute “Stolen”; strike beginning with “altering” in line 3 down through “vehicles” in line 6 and substitute “requiring a police department that takes into custody a vehicle that has been reported stolen to provide, within a certain period of time, a certain notice to the last known registered owner of the vehicle; and generally relating to reporting requirements and stolen vehicles”; and strike in their entirety lines 7 through 16, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY adding to

Article - Transportation

Section 14-105.2

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2009 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 8 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

“**14-105.2.**

**WITHIN 3 DAYS AFTER TAKING A VEHICLE THAT HAS BEEN REPORTED  
STOLEN INTO CUSTODY, A POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL:**

**(1) SEND NOTICE TO THE LAST KNOWN OWNER OF THE VEHICLE  
BY CERTIFIED MAIL, RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED; AND**

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**(2) PROVIDE NOTICE BY TELEPHONE TO THE LAST KNOWN REGISTERED OWNER OF THE VEHICLE IF A TELEPHONE NUMBER FOR THE OWNER IS AVAILABLE.**
