AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 884

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Gas," insert "Sewer,"; in line 5, after "water," insert "sewer,"; in line 6, strike "at certain affected condominium units" and substitute "conspicuously at or near the entry to the common area"; strike beginning with "and" in line 6 down through "units" in line 8; in line 10, strike "on" and substitute "at"; in line 11, strike "of certain units" and substitute "to the common area"; and in line 12, after "gas," insert "sewer,".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with the colon in line 33 down through "**POST**" in line 34 and substitute "**POST**"; and in line 35, strike "**; AND**" and substitute a period.

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 and 2.

On page 4, strike beginning with the colon in line 6 down through "**POST**" in line 7 and substitute "**POST**"; and strike beginning with the semicolon in line 8 down through "**UNIT**" in line 10.

On page 5, strike beginning with the colon in line 19 down through "**POST**" in line 20 and substitute "**POST**"; and strike beginning with the semicolon in line 21 down through "**UNIT**" in line 23.

On page 6, in lines 6 and 7, strike ": (1)"; and strike beginning with the semicolon in line 8 down through "UNIT" in line 10.

On page 8, in lines 2 and 3, strike ": (I)"; and strike beginning with the semicolon in line 4 down through "UNIT" in line 6.

On page 2 in line 34, on page 4 in line 7, on page 5 in line 20, on page 6 in line 7, and on page 8 in line 3, in each instance, strike "AT EACH AFFECTED UNIT" and substitute "CONSPICUOUSLY AT OR NEAR THE ENTRY TO THE COMMON AREA".

On page 3, in lines 5 and 6, strike "AT OR NEAR THE ENTRY OF EACH AFFECTED UNIT".

On page 4 in lines 13 and 14, on page 5 in lines 26 and 27, on page 6 in lines 13 and 14, and on page 8 in lines 9 and 10, in each instance, strike "ON OR NEAR THE ENTRY OF EACH AFFECTED UNIT".
