AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after "Washington," insert "<u>Tarrant</u>,"; in the same line, strike "and Smigiel" and substitute "<u>Smigiel</u>, <u>Barkley</u>, <u>Barnes</u>, <u>Braveboy</u>, <u>Hucker</u>, <u>Jameson</u>, <u>McHale</u>, <u>and Vaughn</u>"; in line 2, after "Protection" insert "<u>and Exclusions</u>"; and in line 10, after "information;" insert "<u>prohibiting an employee from downloading certain unauthorized information or data to certain Web sites or Webbased accounts; providing that an employer, based on the receipt of certain information regarding the use of certain Web sites or certain Web-based accounts, is not prevented from conducting certain investigations for certain purposes;".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 29, insert:

"(D) AN EMPLOYEE MAY NOT DOWNLOAD UNAUTHORIZED EMPLOYER PROPRIETARY INFORMATION OR FINANCIAL DATA TO AN EMPLOYEE'S PERSONAL WEB SITE, AN INTERNET WEB SITE, A WEB-BASED ACCOUNT, OR A SIMILAR ACCOUNT.

(E) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PREVENT AN EMPLOYER:

A PERSONAL WEB SITE, INTERNET WEB SITE, WEB-BASED ACCOUNT, OR SIMILAR ACCOUNT BY AN EMPLOYEE FOR BUSINESS PURPOSES, FROM CONDUCTING AN INVESTIGATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENSURING COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE SECURITIES OR FINANCIAL LAW, OR REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS; OR

(2) BASED ON THE RECEIPT OF INFORMATION ABOUT THE UNAUTHORIZED DOWNLOADING OF AN EMPLOYER'S PROPRIETARY INFORMATION OR FINANCIAL DATA TO A PERSONAL WEB SITE, INTERNET WEB SITE, WEB-BASED ACCOUNT, OR SIMILAR ACCOUNT BY AN EMPLOYEE, FROM INVESTIGATING AN EMPLOYEE'S ACTIONS UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION."
