AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 987

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 3, 10, 13, 14, 16, 25, and 27, in each instance, strike “each” and substitute “a”; in lines 3, 10, 13, 14, 16, 26, and 27, in each instance, strike “and” and substitute “or”; and in line 3, after “municipality” insert “subject to a certain municipal stormwater permit”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with “ON” in line 8 down through “(B)” in line 11 and substitute “**(1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY THAT IS SUBJECT TO A NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PHASE I MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM PERMIT.**

(2)”;

and after line 16, insert:

“(B) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2013, A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT LOCAL LAWS OR ORDINANCES NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH A WATERSHED PROTECTION AND RESTORATION PROGRAM.”

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3 in line 21, on page 4 in lines 1 and 10, on page 5 in lines 24, 27, and 30, and on page 6 in line 11, in each instance, strike “EACH” and substitute “A”.

(Over)

On page 3 in lines 21 and 30, on page 4 in lines 1 and 10, on page 5 in lines 24, 27, and 30, and on page 6 in line 11, in each instance, strike “AND” and substitute “OR”.

On page 3, in line 30, strike “EACH” and substitute and “A”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 27, strike “IN ACCORDANCE WITH” and substitute “A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY ESTABLISH”; in line 28, strike “ESTABLISHED BY A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY AND” and substitute a comma; and in line 29, strike “A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY” and substitute “TO”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 5, in line 8, after “REDUCTION” insert “, INCLUDING GUIDELINES:”

1. RELATING TO PROPERTIES WITH EXISTING ADVANCED STORMWATER BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES;

2. RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES OR FACILITIES THAT ARE OTHERWISE EXEMPTED FROM STORMWATER MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS BY THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY; AND

3. THAT ACCOUNT FOR THE COSTS OF, AND THE LEVEL OF TREATMENT PROVIDED BY, STORMWATER MANAGEMENT FACILITIES THAT ARE FUNDED AND MAINTAINED BY A PROPERTY OWNER”.
