FOR THE APPROVED CURRICULUM IN A PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL THAT INCLUDES OR REFERENCES SAME-SEX RELATIONSHIPS SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF A CHILD WHO ATTENDS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL.

(2) (I) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL ALLOW A CHILD TO BE EXCUSED FROM ANY INSTRUCTION THAT ADDRESSES SAME-SEX RELATIONSHIPS ON WRITTEN REQUEST OF THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF THE CHILD.

(II) THE SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE AN EXCUSED CHILD WITH APPROPRIATE LEARNING ACTIVITIES.

(III) <u>A CHILD WHO IS OFFICIALLY EXCUSED FROM</u> INSTRUCTION THAT ADDRESSES SAME-SEX RELATIONSHIPS MAY NOT BE ACADEMICALLY PENALIZED IN ANY WAY AS A RESULT OF BEING EXCUSED.".
