CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Electric Companies – Generation Request for Proposals – Expansion of Area**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Public Service Commission to consider all areas of
4 the State when determining the need for additional electricity generation;
5 requiring an electric company to reference generation potential in all areas of
6 the State in a request for proposals submitted to the Commission; specifying
7 certain criteria that an electric company shall consider in a request for
8 proposals; providing for the application of this Act; making this Act an
9 emergency measure; and generally relating to electricity generation.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Public Utilities**

18 **7–214.**

19 **(A) WHEN CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR NEW ELECTRIC GENERATION**
20 **FACILITIES UNDER § 7–510(C)(6) OF THIS TITLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL**

1 INCLUDE ALL AREAS OF THE STATE IN THE SCOPE PROVISION OF A DRAFT
2 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS.

3 (B) (1) WHEN THE COMMISSION REQUIRES AN ELECTRIC COMPANY
4 TO SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR NEW GENERATION FACILITIES, THE
5 ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL REFER TO GENERATION CAPACITY IN ALL AREAS OF
6 THE STATE.

7 (2) AN ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL CONSIDER GENERATION
8 CAPACITY IN TERMS OF LOCATION, ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFITS,
9 AND OTHER APPROPRIATE FACTORS.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
11 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
12 any effect on or application to any request for proposals submitted before the effective
13 date of this Act.

14 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
15 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
16 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
17 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
18 effect from the date it is enacted.
