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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration – Copy of Driving Record – Reduction of Fee**  
3 **for Additional Copies**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to charge a certain fee  
5 for each additional driving record requested at the same time as the first  
6 driving record; and generally relating to copies of driving records.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 12–113.

16 (a) (1) Subject to § 12–111 of this subtitle and § 10–616(p) of the State  
17 Government Article, the Administrator or any other officer or employee of the  
18 Administration designated by the Administrator may furnish on request a copy or a  
19 certified copy of any record of the Administration.

20 (2) **(I)** The Administration [may]:

1                                   1.     **MAY** establish and charge a fee for each record it  
2 furnishes or certifies; **AND**

3                                   2.     **SHALL CHARGE A FEE NOT TO EXCEED \$2 FOR**  
4 **EACH ADDITIONAL DRIVING RECORD REQUESTED AT THE SAME TIME AS THE**  
5 **FIRST DRIVING RECORD.**

6                                   **(II)**   The revenue from the fee shall not be subject to the  
7 distribution provisions of Title 8, Subtitle 4, of this article.

8                                   (3)    No charge shall be made to a police agency, fire department, or  
9 court in this or any other state or a police agency or court of the United States  
10 government.

11                                  (4)    The fee established and charged under this section may exceed the  
12 amounts authorized under § 10-621 of the State Government Article.

13                                  **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect**  
14 **October 1, 2012.**
