1 AN ACT concerning

Zoning, Construction, and Stormwater – Permits and Variances – Solar Panels

FOR the purpose of providing that, for the purposes of issuing a permit or a variance 4 $\mathbf{5}$ relating to zoning, construction, or stormwater for a project to install a solar 6 panel, any calculation relating to the impervious surface of the project required 7 by certain State or local governing authorities may include only a certain 8 portion of the foundation or base supporting the solar panel; establishing a 9 certain exception; defining a certain term; providing for the effective date of this 10 Act; and generally relating to the calculation of impervious surfaces for the 11 purposes of issuing a permit or a variance relating to zoning, construction, or 12 stormwater.
