- FOR the purpose of requiring that the investments of certain special funds reflect the diversity of the State; prohibiting certain special funds from receiving fees from the public unless the industry that benefits from the special fund meets certain requirements; requiring the Governor's Office of Minority Affairs to provide by regulation a certain determination; requiring the State Treasurer, in consultation with the Governor's Office of Minority Affairs, to provide a certain report by a certain date; defining a certain term; and generally relating to a requirement that certain special funds be administered in a certain manner.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Finance and Procurement

- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SPECIAL FUND" MEANS A FUND ESTABLISHED BY LAW TO BENEFIT OR EXPAND AN INDUSTRY IN THE STATE.
- 22 (B) (1) THE TREASURER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE GOVERNOR'S
 23 OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS, SHALL REQUIRE THAT INVESTMENTS OF A

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before January 1, 2013, the Treasurer, in consultation with the Governor's Office of Minority Affairs, shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on any special funds that are not in compliance with this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2012.
