Criminal Procedure - Retention of Right to Expungement

FOR the purpose of establishing that whether a person is entitled to expungement of one charge or conviction arising from an incident, transaction, or set of facts does not affect the person's right to expungement of another charge or conviction arising from the same incident, transaction, or set of facts; making certain conforming changes; and generally relating to the expungement of criminal charges.

- 18 (a) [(1)] In this subtitle, if two or more charges **OR CONVICTIONS**[, other 19 than one for a minor traffic violation,] arise from the same incident, transaction, or set 20 of facts, they are considered to be a unit.
- [(2) A charge for a minor traffic violation that arises from the same incident, transaction, or set of facts as a charge in the unit is not a part of the unit.]

- (2) The disposition of a charge for a minor traffic violation that arises from the same incident, transaction, or set of facts as a charge in the unit does not affect any right to expungement of a charge or conviction in the unit] WHETHER A PERSON IS ENTITLED TO EXPUNGEMENT OF ONE CHARGE OR CONVICTION IN A UNIT DOES NOT AFFECT ANY RIGHT TO EXPUNGEMENT OF ANY OTHER CHARGE OR CONVICTION IN THE UNIT.
