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- FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor, beginning with a certain fiscal year, to include in the State budget for each fiscal year a certain appropriation of at least a certain amount to support the Upper Shore Regional Council; and generally relating to a mandatory appropriation for the Upper Shore Regional Council.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article – Economic Development

- 22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 23 (c) "Council" means the Upper Shore Regional Council.



- 1 13–1008.
- 2 (a) The State and Cecil, Kent, and Queen Anne's counties may jointly finance 3 the Council and its activities.
- 4 (b) (1) The State may provide financial support to the Council to assist in carrying out the activities of the Council.
- 6 (2) (i) On or before August 1 of each year, the Council shall submit 7 its proposed work programs and operating budget for the following fiscal year to the 8 Department.
- 9 (ii) The submission shall include supporting schedules to show 10 how the budget is financed, and to provide for review and recommendations.
- 11 (iii) After review, the Department shall forward the submission 12 and any recommendations to the Department of Budget and Management for 13 consideration.
- 14 (3) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, 15 THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION OF 16 AT LEAST \$200,000 TO SUPPORT THE COUNCIL.
- 17 (c) (1) The governing bodies of Cecil, Kent, and Queen Anne's counties 18 each year shall appropriate to the Council at least \$10,000 each to foster cooperative 19 planning and development in the region.
- 20 (2) Cecil, Kent, and Queen Anne's counties may appropriate any other 21 money for the Council as they consider necessary and appropriate.
- 22 (3) Other political subdivisions, including special districts, may 23 appropriate money for the Council as they consider necessary and appropriate.
- 24 (d) The Council may accept additional money from any other public or 25 private source.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
