4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members of the ~~Board of~~ Carroll
5 Community College Board of Trustees ~~for Carroll County~~; requiring the
6 Governor to make certain appointments to the Board for a term that begins on a
7 certain date; and generally relating to the ~~Board of~~ Carroll Community College
8 Board of Trustees ~~for Carroll County~~.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Education**

2 (a) There is a board of community college trustees in each county that has
3 one or more community colleges.

4 (b) (1) The governing body of any county that does not have a community
5 college may request permission to establish one from the Maryland Higher Education
6 Commission.

7 (2) On recommendation of the Commission, the Governor shall
8 appoint a board of community college trustees for that county.

9 (c) Except as provided in Subtitle 4 of this title, each board is composed of
10 seven members appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate.

11 (d) (1) Except as provided in Subtitle 4 of this title, each member serves
12 for a term of 6 years from July 1 of the year the appointment is made and until a
13 successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered, and of the initial
14 appointments to a board, five shall be for terms of 1 to 5 years respectively, and two
15 shall be for terms of 6 years.

16 (2) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves
17 only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

18 (3) A member may be reappointed.

20 **(A) ~~THE BOARD OF CARROLL COMMUNITY COLLEGE~~ BOARD OF
21 TRUSTEES FOR CARROLL COUNTY CONSISTS OF NINE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY
22 THE GOVERNOR, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.**

23 **(B) EACH YEAR THE MEMBERS SHALL ELECT A CHAIR FROM AMONG
24 THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.**

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the two additional
26 members of the ~~Board of Carroll~~ Community College Board of Trustees for Carroll
27 ~~County~~ authorized under this Act shall be appointed by the Governor at large for a
28 term of office that begins on July 1, 2012.

29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
30 June 1, 2012.
