SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article – Environment
6–1402.
On or after July 1, [2012] 2013 , a person may not manufacture, sell, offer for
sale, or distribute in the State any children's jewelry that contains cadmium at more
than 0.0075% by weight.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
June 1, 2012.
