AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 224  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after “proof;” insert “requiring an election judge, under certain circumstances, to issue a voter a temporary voting authority card, have the voter sign the temporary voting authority card, and issue the voter a certain ballot; requiring a voter who receives a temporary voting authority card and a certain ballot to prove residency by presenting to the State Board certain documentation within a certain time period;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in lines 15 and 24, in each instance, strike “**IF**” and substitute “**EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF**”; after line 20, insert:

**“(3) (I) IF THE VOTER SHOWS AN ELECTION JUDGE AN OFFICIAL DOCUMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2)(II) OF THIS SECTION TO PROVE RESIDENCY IN THE COUNTY AND IS QUALIFIED TO REGISTER TO VOTE, THE ELECTION JUDGE SHALL:**

**1. ISSUE TO THE VOTER A TEMPORARY VOTING AUTHORITY CARD;**

**2. HAVE THE VOTER SIGN THE TEMPORARY VOTING AUTHORITY CARD; AND**

**3. ISSUE TO THE VOTER A PROVISIONAL BALLOT.**

(II) WITHIN 2 WEEKS AFTER A VOTER IS ISSUED A TEMPORARY VOTING AUTHORITY CARD AND A PROVISIONAL BALLOT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE VOTER SHALL PROVE RESIDENCY BY PRESENTING TO THE STATE BOARD A MARYLAND DRIVER'S LICENSE OR MARYLAND IDENTIFICATION CARD THAT CONTAINS THE VOTER'S CURRENT ADDRESS.”;

and after line 30, insert:

“(3) (I) IF THE VOTER SHOWS AN ELECTION JUDGE AN OFFICIAL DOCUMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2)(II) OF THIS SECTION TO PROVE RESIDENCY IN THE COUNTY AND IS QUALIFIED TO REGISTER TO VOTE, THE ELECTION JUDGE SHALL:

1. ISSUE TO THE VOTER A TEMPORARY VOTING AUTHORITY CARD;
2. HAVE THE VOTER SIGN THE TEMPORARY VOTING AUTHORITY CARD; AND
3. ISSUE TO THE VOTER THE APPROPRIATE PROVISIONAL BALLOT FOR THE VOTER'S NEW ADDRESS.

(II) WITHIN 2 WEEKS AFTER A VOTER IS ISSUED A TEMPORARY VOTING AUTHORITY CARD AND A PROVISIONAL BALLOT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE VOTER SHALL PROVE RESIDENCY BY PRESENTING TO THE STATE BOARD A MARYLAND DRIVER'S LICENSE OR MARYLAND IDENTIFICATION CARD THAT CONTAINS THE VOTER'S CURRENT ADDRESS.”.
