AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 276, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In the Judicial Proceedings Committee Amendments (SB0276/258274/1), in line 4 in Amendment No. 1, before “altering” insert “prohibiting the extradition of a certain person to a certain other state or country in certain circumstances;”; and in line 6, strike “and 7-107(b)” and substitute “7-107(b), and 9-102”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 10 of the bill, after line 14, insert:

“9-102.

(A) [Subject] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION AND SUBJECT to the provisions of this title, the provisions of the Constitution of the United States controlling, and any and all acts of Congress enacted in pursuance thereof, it is the duty of the Governor of this State to have arrested and delivered up to the executive authority of any other state any person charged in that state with treason, felony, or other crime, who has fled from justice and is found in this State.

(B) A PERSON MAY NOT BE EXTRADITED FROM THIS STATE TO ANOTHER STATE OR COUNTRY IN WHICH THE PERSON HAS BEEN OR COULD BE CHARGED WITH A CRIME THAT WOULD SUBJECT THE PERSON TO THE DEATH PENALTY IN THE STATE OR COUNTRY.”.
