AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 207, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments (SB0297/490412/1), in line 10 of Amendment No. 1, after “designate” insert “. subject to the approval of a certain local governing body.”; and strike beginning with “providing” in line 18 down through “Act” in line 19 and substitute “providing for the application of this Act”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 11 of the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments, in line 8 of Amendment No. 1, after “DESIGNATE” insert “, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE LOCAL JURISDICTION,”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 18 of the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments, in Amendment No. 2, strike beginning with “a” in line 9 down through “interest” in line 17 and substitute “this Act shall apply only to a contract entered into on or after April 9, 2013, and may not be construed to affect a contract entered into before April 9, 2013.”.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for a speed monitoring system contract entered into by a local jurisdiction before April 9, 2013, the local jurisdiction may not extend the term of the contract by exercising an extension option or clause”.
