FOR the purpose of requiring an individual who is operating a moped or motor scooter
on a highway in the State to possess a valid driver's license or a valid moped
operator's permit issued to the individual; making a certain technical correction;
and generally relating to the operation of a moped or motor scooter on a
highway in the State.

1 Each individual operating on any highway in this State a moped, as (b)  $\mathbf{2}$ defined in § 11–134.1 of this article or a motor scooter, as defined in § 11–134.5 of this 3 article, shall have with the individual: 4 A VALID driver's license issued to the individual under this title, (1) $\mathbf{5}$ which license may be of any class issued by the Administration; 6 (2)If the individual is a nonresident of this State, a VALID DRIVER'S 7license [to drive] issued to the individual by the state or country of the individual's 8 residence, which license may be for any class of vehicle; or 9 A VALID moped operator's permit issued to the individual under (3)this subtitle. 10 11 16 - 104.2.12On application, the Administration shall issue a moped operator's permit (a) 13to an applicant who:

Is 16 years of age or older;

15 (2) Does not possess a valid driver's license issued by this State or any 16 other jurisdiction, but whose license or privilege to drive is not revoked, suspended, 17 refused, or canceled;

18 (3) Provides satisfactory documentary evidence that the applicant has19 lawful status; and

20 (4) (i) Provides satisfactory documentary evidence that the 21 applicant has a valid Social Security number by presenting the applicant's Social 22 Security Administration account card or, if the Social Security Administration account 23 card is not available, any of the following documents bearing the applicant's Social 24 Security number:

1 (d) (1) A permit is not valid unless the applicant signs the applicant's 2 name on it in the applicant's usual signature.

3 (2) When issued and signed, a moped operator's permit only 4 authorizes its holder to operate a moped, as defined in § 11–134.1 of this article or a 5 motor scooter, as defined in § 11–134.5 of this article.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2013.
