A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Health – Food Allergy Awareness

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain food establishments to display, in a certain 4 manner and location, a certain poster relating to food allergies and to include on $\mathbf{5}$ a menu provided by the food establishment a notice to a customer that the 6 customer should inform the server of any food allergies; requiring, on or before a 7 certain date, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in consultation 8 with certain entities, to create and make available on its Web site a certain 9 poster and certain notice: requiring certain individuals to view a certain video 10 and be knowledgeable about certain issues concerning food allergies and food 11 preparation under certain circumstances; requiring the Department, in 12consultation with certain entities, to develop a certain program for food establishments to be designated as food allergy friendly, issue certain guidelines 1314 and requirements regarding the program, and maintain and make available to 15the public on its Web site a certain list of food establishments; authorizing the 16 Department to adopt regulations to carry out certain provisions of this Act; 17requiring the Governor to annually proclaim a certain week as Food Allergy 18 Awareness Week; requiring the Department, in consultation with certain 19 entities, to report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a 20certain date regarding the impact of certain provisions of this Act; defining a 21certain term; and generally relating to food allergy awareness.

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(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

8 (1) DEVELOP, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE RESTAURANT 9 ASSOCIATION OF MARYLAND AND THE FOOD ALLERGY & ANAPHYLAXIS 10 NETWORK, A VOLUNTARY PROGRAM FOR FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS TO BE 11 DESIGNATED AS FOOD ALLERGY FRIENDLY;

12 (2) ISSUE GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS THAT A FOOD 13 ESTABLISHMENT MUST MEET TO BE DESIGNATED AS FOOD ALLERGY FRIENDLY, 14 INCLUDING A REQUIREMENT TO MAINTAIN ON THE PREMISES OF THE FOOD 15 ESTABLISHMENT AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC A MASTER LIST OF ALL 16 INGREDIENTS USED IN THE PREPARATION OF EACH FOOD ITEM AVAILABLE FOR 17 PUBLIC CONSUMPTION; AND

18 **(3)** MAINTAIN AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON THE 19 DEPARTMENT'S WEB SITE A LIST OF FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS THAT HAVE BEEN 20 DESIGNATED AS FOOD ALLERGY FRIENDLY.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before September 29 30, 2015, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, in consultation with the 30 Restaurant Association of Maryland and the Food Allergy & Anaphylaxis Network, 31 shall report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government 32 Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article,

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- on the impact of § 21–330.2 of the Health General Article, as enacted by Section 1 of
 this Act, including the compliance rate of food establishments.
- 3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 4 October 1, 2013.
