## A BILL ENTITLED

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## Minority Business Enterprises - Time Frame and Monitoring of Payments

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt certain regulations 4 that require a unit to authorize payment to a prime contractor within a certain 5 number of days after completion of the work required by contracts containing 6 minority business enterprise participation goals; requiring the Board, in 7 conjunction with the Governor's Office of Minority Affairs, to establish a process 8 for monitoring certain payments; and generally relating to the adoption of 9 regulations by the Board of Public Works concerning payments to a prime 10 contractor under contracts containing minority business enterprise 11 participation goals.
