10 (a) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A 11 permit expires on the last day of the holder's birth month following 2 years after the 12 date the permit is issued.

13 (b) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A 14 permit may be renewed for successive periods of 3 years each if, at the time of an 15 application for renewal, the applicant possesses the qualifications for the issuance of a 16 permit and pays the renewal fee stated in this subtitle.

17 (C) A PERMIT ISSUED TO A RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF 18 THE STATE OR A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE:

19(1) EXPIRES ON THE LAST DAY OF THE HOLDER'S BIRTH MONTH20FOLLOWING 5 YEARS AFTER THE DATE THE PERMIT IS ISSUED; AND

(2) MAY BE RENEWED FOR SUCCESSIVE PERIODS OF 5 YEARS
 EACH IF, AT THE TIME OF AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL, THE APPLICANT
 POSSESSES THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT.

 October 1, 2013.
