## Electric Companies – Rate Adjustment or Fees to Recover Profits Lost During Service Disruption – Prohibition

### 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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### Article – Public Utilities

17 **4–307.** 

### 18 THE COMMISSION MAY NOT AUTHORIZE AN ELECTRIC COMPANY TO 19 ADJUST THE ELECTRIC COMPANY'S RATES OR IMPOSE ANY FEE TO RECOVER 20 PROFITS LOST DURING A DISRUPTION IN ELECTRICAL SERVICE.

## SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
