2 **State Government – Commemorative ~~Day~~ Month – German–American**
3 **Heritage ~~Day~~ Month**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain ~~day~~ month
5 as German–American Heritage ~~Day~~ Month; requiring the proclamation to urge
6 certain organizations to observe the ~~day~~ month with certain activities; and
7 generally relating to German–American Heritage ~~Day~~ Month.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – State Government**

4 **13-411.**

5 (A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT GERMAN
6 AMERICANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL
7 PROCLAIM OCTOBER ~~3~~ AS GERMAN-AMERICAN HERITAGE ~~DAY~~ MONTH.

8 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL
9 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE GERMAN-AMERICAN HERITAGE ~~DAY~~ MONTH
10 PROPERLY WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 July 1, 2013.
