1 AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - 40th and 41st Legislative Districts - Alcoholic Beverages Store Closing Hours

FOR the purpose of altering the time at which establishments issued certain Class A alcoholic beverages licenses in the 40th and 41st Legislative Districts in Baltimore City must stop selling alcoholic beverages; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages sales in Baltimore City.

17 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the hours during 18 which the privileges conferred by a Class A beer and light wine license may be 19 exercised are from 6 a.m. to midnight on every day except Sunday.

20 (2) In the Park Heights Redevelopment Area that is specified in the 21 Park Heights Master Plan adopted by Baltimore City in 2006, the hours of sale begin 22 at 9 a.m. each day.
