13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 Article State Government
- 16 **13–504.**

(A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT IRISH AMERICANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF MARCH EACH YEAR AS IRISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH.

20 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 21 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE IRISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH PROPERLY 22 WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.
