1 (V) (1) A CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF A RECORD OF A 2 HANDGUN PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 5–306 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE 3 AND OF A HANDGUN PERMIT APPLICATION MADE UNDER § 5–304 OF THE 4 PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.

5 (2) A CUSTODIAN SHALL PERMIT INSPECTION OF THE RECORDS 6 SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION BY THE HANDGUN PERMIT 7 HOLDER OR HANDGUN PERMIT APPLICANT.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2013.
