Public Utilities - Telephone Service - Charges for Directory Assistance

- FOR the purpose of specifying that certain residential customers are entitled to only a certain number of directory assistance calls each month without charge; requiring the Public Service Commission to approve other charges for directory assistance, subject to a certain exception; repealing a provision that authorizes
- assistance, subject to a certain exception; repealing a provision that authorizes the Commission to establish additional exemptions from directory assistance

- 18 (a) (1) The Commission may not authorize telephone company charges to
- 19 be levied for directory assistance calls made by residential customers on the first two
- 20 calls made to directory assistance from each residential service per monthly billing
- 21 cycle.
- 22 (2) [The] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE
- 23 Commission [may] SHALL authorize charges on other directory assistance calls [if the
- 24 Commission finds, after notice and evidentiary hearing, that the charges:

3	(ii) encourage the development of competition; and

5 6 7	(b) The Commission may not authorize telephone company charges to be levied for directory assistance on an individual who suffers from a physical or visual disability that precludes the use of a telephone directory.
8 9	[(c) The Commission may provide other exemptions from telephone company charges to be levied for directory assistance if the exemptions are just and reasonable.]
10 11	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
