## **HOUSE BILL 182**

- 1 (2) A person who has a license issued under Title 16 of this article to act as a cigarette wholesaler **OR TO ACT AS A CIGARETTE SUBWHOLESALER** is not required to pay the license fee.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2013.
