person from willfully and knowingly preventing, hindering, or delaying another
person from signing a petition by certain means; and generally relating to
prohibited actions relating to petitions.

- 17 (a) A person may not willfully and knowingly:

(1) give, transfer, promise, or offer anything of value for the purpose of
 inducing another person to sign or not sign any petition;
