4 certain former service members for relevant military training, education, and
5 experience in connection with the issuance of certain occupational and
6 professional licenses, certificates, and registrations; repealing and recodifying
7 certain provisions of law regarding the renewal of certain occupational or
8 professional licenses and the completion of continuing education or continuing
9 competency requirements for certain members of an armed force deployed
10 outside the State; requiring certain licensing units and boards to issue a
11 temporary expedited license, certification, or registration to certain individuals
12 under certain circumstances; authorizing certain licensing units and boards to
13 issue a temporary license under certain circumstances; ~~authorizing certain~~
