- FOR the purpose of altering the length of time of the term of office of a member of the
 Board of Regents of Morgan State University; setting a limit on the number of
 terms that <u>a member certain members</u> <u>a member</u> may serve; <u>limiting the</u>
 <u>number of certain members who are not residents of Maryland;</u> and generally
 relating to the terms <u>and residency</u> of members of the Board of Regents of
 Morgan State University.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except for a member of 8 the Board of Regents of Morgan State University who is an elected official, a member who was appointed to the Board of Regents on or before December 31, 2012, may not 9 10 serve, on completion of that term of office, more than one additional term of 5 years.
