## University of Maryland Medical System Corporation - Public Information Act

FOR the purpose of applying the provisions of the Public Information Act to the University of Maryland Medical System Corporation; and generally relating to the University of Maryland Medical System Corporation.

Article - Education
Section 13-303(a)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(2008 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Education

13-303.
(a) Prior to the transfer date:
(1) The Board of Public Works shall approve the articles of incorporation of the Medical System Corporation which shall reflect the requirements of this subtitle; and
(2) The Board of Regents and the Board of Directors shall take all actions necessary to create and organize the Medical System Corporation, which shall be organized for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes and shall attain and maintain exemption from federal income taxation but which shall not be a State agency, political subdivision, public body, public corporation, or municipal corporation

and, except for the provisions of the Public Information Act, Title 10, Subtitle 6, Part III of the State Government Article, is not subject to any provisions of law affecting only governmental or public entities.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
