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Public Schools - Requirements for Controlled Access

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a new school or a renovated school that receives State public school construction funds, including Aging Schools Program funds and 4 5 Qualified Zone Academy Bonds, to be constructed or renovated to have 6 controlled access to allow visitors to enter the school: providing for the 7 application of this Act to the construction or the renovation of certain schools 8 that have not initiated a certain Request For Proposal on or before are approved 9 by the Interagency Committee on School Construction on or after a certain date; 10 requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt certain regulations; defining a 11 certain term; and generally relating to requirements for controlled access to 12 allow visitors to enter public schools in the State.

3	STAFF HAS THE ABILITY INCLUDES THE ABILITY OF SCHOOL STAFF TO:

5	(2) Only allow visitors to enter the school after the

14	BY THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2013.
15	(C) A NEW SCHOOL OR A RENOVATED SCHOOL THAT RECEIVES STATE
16	PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FUNDS, INCLUDING AGING SCHOOLS
17	PROGRAM FUNDS AND QUALIFIED ZONE ACADEMY BONDS, SHALL BE
18	CONSTRUCTED OR RENOVATED TO HAVE CONTROLLED ACCESS TO ALLOW
19	VISITORS TO ENTER THE SCHOOL.
20	(D) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO
