16 17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 21 22	(f) (1) The county governing bodies of the counties that support a regional community college jointly shall review the budget of the regional community college and may reduce it.
23 24	(2) (I) [Approval] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, APPROVAL of the budget by a SIMPLE majority of the counties



- 1 that support a regional community college constitutes approval of the budget and

- 3 (II) 1. THIS SUBPARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY TO A 4 BUDGET PERTAINING TO CHESAPEAKE COLLEGE.

A PROPOSED BUDGET CONTAINING ANY NEW CAPITAL ITEM OR PROGRAM FOR CAPITAL ITEMS THAT WOULD REQUIRE A MEMBER COUNTY TO ISSUE DEBT, PARTICIPATE IN DEBT, OR INCUR AN OBLIGATION TO SHARE IN ANY MANNER IN DEBT OR DEBT SUPPORT SHALL REQUIRE APPROVAL OF A SIMPLE MAJORITY PLUS ONE OF THE MEMBER COUNTIES TO BIND THE MEMBER COUNTIES AS TO THE ITEM OR PROGRAM.

If a simple majority plus one does not approve a capital item or program described in subsubparagraph 2 of this subparagraph, the item or program is deleted from the budget and the remainder of the budget is subject to the simple majority approval requirement specified under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2013.
