- 23 (u) (1) The Office of the Comptroller may issue a winery special event
- permit to a licensed Class 4 Maryland limited winery, provided that:

24	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect			
25	July 1, 2013.
